Building Permits – Comparative Monthly Water Consumption

The town's water consumption is improving and there was a discussion on whether or not to issue more building permits. It was noted that the town has had more water restrictions during the past few summers and that there is some question about the accuracy of our flow meter. Everyone agreed that the numbers are so much better but that we would have a new meter

installed. The town's water consumption is monitored on a daily basis and we will allow some time after the installation to make a more informed decision on lifting the development ban.
