• Management of Incoming Communications – I intend to make a motion to have all incoming communication that is addressed to the Town Council as a whole or to individual members, including any communication directed to the Town Office that raises community concerns; provided to all council members. Ideally this would follow

the procedure as set out on page 4.8 of the Municipal Council Handbook. Communication shall include letters, email, electronic messages, phone calls and cases whereby residents address council members and/or employees individually with town concerns. — Deferred

- Presentations of Financials I intend to make a motion to modify the procedure of how financials are presented at each monthly council meeting. To ensure that Council has a complete understanding of the Town's financial position I ask that in addition to the Accounts Payable listing and bank reconciliation the following be added: Aging Summary Accounts Payable, Summary of Accounts Receivable (not detailed), a Variance Report (comparing budget vs actual spending sample worksheet can be obtained from Municipal & Provincial Affairs) be presented, and a cash inflow report. All should be dated to the end of the previous month Deferred
- Financial Policy & Security I intend to make a motion that a Financial Committee be appointed. The Financial committee would be responsible to review (create) the financial policy & procedure manuals and to ensure checks and balances are in place for all financial matters, including a cheque numbering review and receipt numbering review Deferred
- Live Streaming/Recording of Monthly Council Meetings I intend to make a motion that Monthly council meetings are public meetings and as such should be available to all residents by the introduction of live streaming or live audio recordings. This would allow General Council Meetings to be more accessible to residents, which is in accordance with the Municipalities Act (1999).
