TO ENSURE MATERIALS ARE COLLECTED ITEMS **MUST BE AT ROADSIDE BY 7:00AM ON TUESDAY, MAY 19th, 2026**. PLEASE SORT ITEMS INTO 3 SEPARATE PILES CONSISTING OF METALS, BULK & HOUSEHOLD AND CLEAR BAGGED GARBAGE. ITEMS PLACED AFTER MAY 19th, 2026 THAT ARE NOT COLLECTED WILL REMAIN THE RESPONSIBILITY OF THE HOMEOWNER FOR DISPOSAL.

## Items that are acceptable:

- Couches, chairs, & Household Furniture
- Mattress/Box Springs,
- Lawn Furniture
- Children's Toys, Bicycles /Tricycles
- Broken Glass (Safely packaged)
- Light Fixtures, Fans: Floor & Ceiling
- Textiles – (Clothing or Bedding)
- Small Appliances
- Household Appliances: Stove, Washer, Dryer,
- Microwave, Hot Water Tank, Fridges, Freezers,
- Furnaces
- Lawn Mowers, Generators and Power Saws: **MUST** be drained of oil and gas.
- BBQ's – **No propane tanks**
- Small Automotive Parts – **under 40 lbs**

## Items that ARE NOT acceptable:

- Compostable Materials: Grass, Branches, Leaves, Lumber, Pallets, Trees
- Automotive Parts exceeding 40 lbs
- Sled bodies / Sleds / ATV Frames / Side by Side Frames
- Construction/Renovation Material - drywall, roof shingles, windows
- Fire Extinguishers, Welding Tanks, AirTank or any other Pressurized Tank.
- Tires
- Gas Cans
- Oil Tanks
- Medical Waste or Liquid Waste
- Hazardous, Explosive or Toxic Waste
- Paint and paint products
- Electronic Waste – tvs, cellphones, computers, etc

Please note if you have metals items such as Microwave, Hot Water Tank, Fridges, Freezers, Furnaces, Lawn Mowers, Generators and Power Saws: **MUST** be drained of oil and gas, BBQ's – **No propane tanks**, Small Automotive Parts – under 40 lbs can be dropped off at the NEWCO bin located in the yard of East Main Auto Repair at 259 Main Road anytime during the year.
