Waste Disposal

Contractor

- 1. It is the responsibility of the Contractor and / or his / her agent to ensure that any garbage which falls off the truck is picked up. In order to prevent this from happening, the Contractor shall equip the disposal truck with a tail gate and shall provide covering in the form of a net, tarpaulin or fully enclosed box.
- 2. Contactors much pick up garbage at all households, commercial establishments, schools and public buildings, however, he / she is directed not to pick up any garbage that is not placed in secured garbage bags and / or cardboard boxes or that exceed forty-five (45) pounds. Contractor shall not remove any receptacles from any of the aforementioned places.
- 3. Garbage must be collected on Monday of each week, starting at 8 a.m. at Darius Benoit's at the top of Wheeler's Hill. If, due to exceptional circumstances, the Contractor finds that the forgoing regulations cannot be complied with, he / she must notify Council of such circumstances. The Contractor shall be responsible for notifying the public, by local radio media, of any change in schedule for garbage pickup. Collection must be done on all sides roads if such roads are passable.
- 4. Council, at its discretion, shall terminate any Garbage Disposal Contract should a Contractor neglect to prosecute the work properly.
- 5. Any Contractor wishing to terminate a contract must give Council a sixty (60) day written notice. In the event that the Contractor fails to comply with the sixty (60) day written notice, Council may charge the Contractor with the cost of garbage collection from the time the contract is terminated until such time that a new contract has been put in place.
- 6. Any cost incurred to Council due to neglect will be charged to the Contractor, or deducted from monies owed the Contractor by Council.
- 7. The Contractor shall permit and facilitate observation of the work by Council and its agents and other public authorities.

Clean-up Week

8. Spring Clean-up to take place for one (1) week during the month of May of each year. Actual date will be determined at the Council Meeting which takes places in April. Regular household garbage will be picked up as usual on Wednesday.

Garbage must be bagged, boxed or securely tied and placed by the roadside for pick-up. Burnables to be kept separately from other items, and any garbage that is not picked up on the first day to be covered or placed in containers.

Wrecks on Property

9. No vehicle shall be scrapped on any propertied without a permit from Council. A time limit of twenty-five (25) days will be given to dismantle the vehicle and if at the end of that time limit, the vehicle is not removed, Council will remove it at the owner's expense.
